STEWARDSHIP

2nd Sunday of Lent

“Here I am!” he answered.” - Genesis 22:11

It is easy to say, “Here I am, Lord,” when we are kneeling in church. But how easy is it to say “Here I am, Lord,” when a neighbor needs our help, when we are invited to join a parish ministry, or when we are asked to provide financial support? Often times we are called when it’s not convenient for us. Discipleship is not always easy, most of the time it will make us uncomfortable and vulnerable.

Ask Father James:

The Transfiguration is the Confirmation of the Divine Mission of Jesus

In Mark 9:2-10, Jesus invited Peter, James and John to come up a mountain with him and while there he was transfigured. What a privilege to be asked to join Jesus for a time of prayer! It is characteristic of Jesus to go pray in a solitary place. On that mountain of transfiguration was where the journey of Lent started. On the mountain of transfiguration, were present, Moses and Elijah, witnessing God speak about his departure (Luke 9:31). Our Lenten journey is leading us to that place of his departure.

After experiencing the transfiguration, Jesus would tell the disciples about what was discussed with him - his impending suffering, death and resurrection and instructed them to guard the messianic secret (Matthew 17:9). Jesus has come to accomplish what the Law and the Prophets prophesied.

The climax of the Transfiguration was the heavenly voice that describes the transfigured Christ (whose true glory and identity have just been misunderstood by Peter!) as "my beloved Son". The Transfiguration revealed the true glory and identity of "the Christ". Jesus is the Christ, the Beloved Son of God. The Transfiguration revealed the heavenly identity of Jesus as God's Son.

Up on top of a mountain has always been a biblical meeting place with God. The cloud signals the glorious theophanic presence of God. It is a place of theophany, not least because it is considered to be halfway between earth and heaven but because it validates what Abraham told Isaac on Mount Moriah, Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son" (Genesis 22:8,14). On the mountain of transfiguration, Jesus, the only begotten son of God would be told that he would be that victim of sacrifice. Moses is considered the representative of the law and Elijah the Prophets. They were witnesses that scriptures foretold this.






