Ask Fr James

Why do we sign our forehead, lips and heart at the reading of the Gospel during Mass?

According to the *Ordo Lectionum Missae* #13, (the Directory for the order of Mass), "the reading of the gospel constitutes the summit of the Liturgy of the Word." At that point, everyone in church stand up to listen because Christ wants to speak to us. In the Gospel, Christ is present in his Word since it is he himself who speaks when the holy gospels are read, the priest carries the book of the gospels and enthrones it on the pulpit, the candles surrounds it and he incenses it and signs it with the cross sign and kisses it at the end as he also blesses the people with the gospel book and the people bow in honour saying "*praise to you Lord Jesus Christ.*"

This gesture of signing ourselves with the Cross sign over our foreheads, lips and hearts is a way of praying, "*May the Lord be in my mind, on my lips and in my heart.*" It is said prior to the reading of the Gospel as a way of prayerfully inviting Christ to come to us in these ways as His sacred Word is proclaimed. That the Lord may open our minds to understand his word, open my lips to proclaim it and my heart to live the message of the gospels.

As Catholics, we all know that the celebration of the Mass is divided into two constituent parts, namely, the "Liturgy of the Word," and the "Liturgy of the Eucharist." The Second Vatican Council constitution on the says: "The two parts namely the liturgy of the word and the liturgy of the Eucharistic, are so closely connected with each other that they form but one single act of worship" (SL #56).

The main part of the Liturgy of the Word is made up of the readings from Sacred Scripture together with the chants occurring between them . The homily, Profession of Faith, and Prayer of the Faithful. In the readings, and as explained by the homily, God speaks to his people, opening up to them the mystery of redemption and salvation, and offering them spiritual nourishment; and Christ himself is present in the midst of the faithful thorough his words.

In the liturgy we both worship God and the Church experience the presence of Christ, her divine Founder. Christ is present in the Word, at the august Sacrifice of the altar, in the person of His ministers and above all under the Eucharistic species.

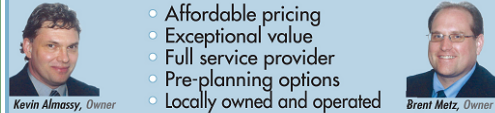
